## Asbestos, Motor Oil, Plate Glass, Mattress, Bed Base & Car Battery Disposal Day

**9am – 2pm, Sunday, 10 March 2019**

### **City of Belmont residents and ratepayers only**

Asbestos, motor oil, plate glass, mattresses, bed bases and car batteries can be disposed of on this day at Council's Operations Centre, 180 Planet Street, Carlisle.

**Computer equipment will not be accepted.**

Asbestos products such as sheets from fences, floors, walls and roofs, old linoleum, brake pads, some insulation, lagging tape, eaves-lining, guttering and pipes can be brought to the Operations Centre for disposal.

Fibrous cement products manufactured after 1987 do not contain asbestos fibres however those manufactured prior to 1987 may do so.

**Asbestos must be wrapped and sealed in heavy duty 'builders' plastic to ensure safe transportation to the depot. Asbestos must be wrapped and sealed for it to be accepted.**

Each household is limited to the **equivalent of six (6) fence sheets only**, so remember to bring a helper if you have a heavy or large load. **No additional asbestos containing material greater than the aforementioned quantity will be accepted.**

For occupational safety and health reasons, motor oil can only be dropped off in containers of no greater volume than 20 litres. Up to 60 litres per resident will be accepted. Motor oil as waste from commercial operations will not be accepted.

**Enclosed foot wear and proof of property ownership or residency within the City of Belmont is required.**
