## Bulk Bins

Most residential properties (excluding medium and high density residential) within the City of Belmont are entitled to four **FREE** bulk bins each financial year.

Residents can choose between **BLUE** bins for household material and **GREEN** bins for garden waste.

Residents are encouraged to use the green bins for green waste such as branches, fronds, prunings and lawn clippings (not turf or sods). This is a great way of saving precious landfill as your green waste will be made into mulch.

- **Weekday** blue bulk bins will, on most occasions, be delivered on either Monday or Tuesday and will remain on site for two evenings and one day.
- **Weekend** blue bulk bins, on most occasions, will be delivered on a Wednesday or Thursday and remain on site over the weekend.
- Green bulk bins will be delivered on a Friday and removed the following Friday.

Where residents need to dispose of much bulkier items, one of their bulk bin entitlements can be exchanged for a tip pass to the Red Hill Waste Management Facility (6x4 trailer). Tip passes can be picked up at the City of Belmont's Administration Building at 215 Wright Street, Cloverdale.

between 8:30am to 5pm, Monday to Friday.

The City's service provider, Cleanaway, takes bin orders over the phone and provides a reference number and an approximate waiting time.

Any other enquiries regarding your weekly rubbish or fortnightly recycling bin can also be reported to Cleanaway.

Please note:

- Do not fill the bulk bin over the top of the bin edge.
- Do not have contents sticking out at angles above the top of the bin, as this can interfere with the truck's lifting gear.
- If you have a green waste bin, only dispose of grass clippings, leaves, branches (1.5m length, 15cm width), plants, prunings and weeds.
