ltem 12.1 Cont.	<ul> <li>If developmental approval is issued and conditions are not adhered to, it may become a compliance issue.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>This is a quasi-judicial decision to be made by Council and therefore the applicant does have the right to appeal.</li> </ul>	
	• The R-Code table for setback is a guide. If the application does not meet the deemed to comply standard, a reduced setback can still be considered, taking into account other factors, e.g. zoning, privacy or overlooking issues etc.	
	• The key issue is the management of the facility and specific conditions have been proposed to ensure it is run cohesively, e.g. 30 minute booking gap, complaints register etc.	
	<ul> <li>If complaints are received or there is non-compliance, Officers will work with the operator and the community with the aim to resolve any issues. Should issues continue, then the City can pursue legal action – other alternatives include infringements for noise issues.</li> </ul>	
	• The building is strictly for community based activities. It cannot become a centre for large competitions or events (e.g. basketball competitions, school discos).	
	<ul> <li>The two-way access is 5.95m wide and has been determined by Infrastructure Services as sufficient for the passing of two vehicles at slow speed.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>The external staircases are to be fully screened from the residential areas.</li> </ul>
