

Stable Premises Manure Management

- Bagged manure cannot be placed on the Council verge **at any time**. Penalties apply (s24 of the Litter Act 1979)
- Any bagged stable waste must be securely tied or sealed, stored up off unsealed ground and protected under cover from sprinklers and rain, **on your private property**.
- Bagged stable waste stored on private property must be removed **weekly** and not allowed to accumulate for longer periods of time.
- All bagged and binned manure must be removed or emptied on private property, with the empty waste storage receptacles and bulk bins returned out of view from the street once serviced.
- Where issues arise with bagged manure stored on private property or on the Council verge, a fly-proof waste receptacle (bulk bin) must be provided for all manure storage/disposal.
- Where the required waste receptacles (bins) are not provided as required by the local law, penalties apply.

Your cooperation in addressing potential health issues and environmental pollution and maintaining the amenity of the area is appreciated.
