1. OFFICIAL OPENING

4. PURPOSE OF MEETING

4.1 REQUEST FOR A SPECIAL MEETING OF ELECTORS – LIVE STREAMING OF COUNCIL MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S (CEO'S) CONTRACT

A request for a Special Meeting of Electors was received by the City of Belmont on 12 August 2019.

Following verification of the request as required under section 5.28 of the *Local Government Act 1995* a Special Electors' Meeting has been called to discuss the following items:

- 1. Live Streaming of Council Meetings
- 2. Access to the CEO's Contract

The Presiding Member advised the following:

'Before the meeting proceeds to the Motions it is necessary for all electors present to be informed of certain obligations that Councillors have.

Under Part 8 of the City of Belmont Standing Orders Local Law 2017 a Councillor is not to speak against any decision of Council except on a Council motion that the decision be revoked or changed.

An electors' meeting cannot legally revoke a decision of the Council. Such a motion would need to be formulated by Council/Councillors to accord with the Local Government Act 1995, Regulations and the Standing Orders Local Law 2017.

Electors are encouraged to provide their views and avoid soliciting Councillors' views that may lead to a legislative breach. A breach of the Standing Orders Local Law 2017 could result in a complaint being dealt with by the Local Government Standards Panel and I would like to see this avoided.

Please note that this meeting is only for elector comment and voting on the motions put. All decisions made this evening will be considered by Council at an Ordinary Council Meeting.'
