

# Passive & Active Reserve Hire

## Fees & Charges 2025/2026

There is a park within a three minute walk of every family home in the City of Belmont. In some situations, the City of Belmont charges fees to utilise Council's passive and active reserves.

<b>Passive Reserve Hire - Events</b>	
A fee is charged for events (per day) <i>Please note: A Public Event Application is also required to be submitted to the City's Health Department.</i>	\$404
<b>Passive Reserve Hire – Weddings/Medium Sized Events</b>	
Weddings/Medium Sized Events	\$136.50
<b>Passive and Active Reserve Hire - Personal Training</b>	
Personal Training / Dog Training (per hour)	\$5.90
<b>Active Reserve Hire – Hourly rate</b>	
Casual rate	\$34.50
Community / Not-for-profit groups	\$23.50
<b>Active Reserve Hire – Wilson Park Netball Courts</b>	
Casual court hire (per court, per hour)	\$15.60
<b>Bonds</b>	
Charges are calculated based on individual applications. The bond amount will vary from \$250 to \$1,500 depending on the event.	
<b>Lost Keys/Swipe Cards</b>	
The cost to replace a lost, misplaced or stolen key will incur a charge of \$57 per key and \$290 charge per set. The cost to replace a lost, misplaced or stolen swipe card will incur a charge of \$57.	
<b>Security Callout Charge</b>	
A security callout fee is \$67.50.
