Glossary

I. Black Swan- Black

The emblem of Western Australia.

2. Ducal Coronet (Crown)- Grey

Symbolises Belmont's relationship to the state of Western Australia.

3. Mantling- Grey and Green

Has no meaning, it is only decorative.

4. Two Wings- Red

Depicts flight and the importance of Perth's International Airport to the City of Belmont.

5. Silver

Symbolises wide open skies.

6. Horse- Grey

Symbolises Belmont's connection to the racing industry.

7. Blue

Symbolises the water of the Swan River.

8. Green

Symbolises open spaces

9. Kiln, Stack and Cog- Black

Symbolises the early brick making industry of Belmont.

10. Masoned Crown- Brown

Symbolises the municipality of the City of Belmont.
