# Perth Airport Runway Works – Update

**Upgrades and regular maintenance of our runways are essential in ensuring continued safe operations at Perth Airport.**

To enable these works, the main runway (03/21) and the cross runway (06/24) are temporarily closed at different times.

During the works, residents and businesses may notice temporary changes to the frequency of flights (either an increase or a decrease), depending on which runway is closed.

We appreciate your understanding as we undertake these important works.

The current works schedule will require the following closures:

Date	Main Runway 03/21 Closure

9 May 2026	Between 8:30am and 4:30pm

Date	Cross Runway 06/24 closure
22 May 2026	Between 7:30am and 3:30pm
