Stable Premises Manure Management



The *City of Belmont Consolidated Local Law* 2020 prohibits the storing of bulk bins, waste storage receptacles and bags used for stable manure waste on Council verges at all times.

The requirements for manure waste storage are:

- Only properties that stable four (4) horses or less may be allowed to use the bag system.
- All stable waste must be bagged, securely tied and stored under shelter away from sprinklers and rain on your private property.
- Bags stored on private property must be removed weekly and not allowed to accumulate for longer periods of time.
- Where ongoing issues arise with bagged manure storage, manure will have to be stored in a fly-proof waste receptacle (bulk bin) within the property.
- All bagged and binned manure must be removed or emptied on private property, with the empty waste storage receptacles and bulk bins returned out of view from the street once serviced.

• Please note infringements apply to contraventions of the Local Law.
