

**Whitegoods Drop-off Day**  
**9:00am – 1:00pm Sunday 21 September 2025**  
**Operations Centre, 180 Planet Street, Carlisle**  
**City of Belmont residents and ratepayers only**

**Items that will be accepted:** Whitegoods, cardboard, polystyrene, fluorescent light globes, motor oil, plate glass, mattresses, bed bases, car batteries and e-waste (e.g. TVs, stereo equipment, computer equipment, phones, and household appliances).

**Items that will not be accepted:** Gas cylinders, fluorescent light tubes, tyres, household hazardous waste such as paint or chemicals, and asbestos.

Whitegoods include refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, dryers, ovens, and dishwashers.

All whitegoods, motor oil, car batteries, mattresses, bed bases and e-waste are recyclable so by using this service you are helping our environment as you clean up. Plate glass is not a recyclable product but can be difficult to dispose of. Please ensure mattresses and bed bases are dry and unsoiled.

There is no limit to the number of appliances you drop off.

Residents are required to pour motor oil into a large oil drum on site; contaminated empty containers are then disposed of on site. Up to 60 litres per resident will be accepted, in containers no larger than 20L each. Motor oil as waste from commercial operations will not be accepted.

**Enclosed footwear and proof of property ownership or residency within the City of Belmont is required.**
