The City's Environment team will be working with community volunteers on Saturday 8 June 2024 to plant native tube stock as part of the Garvey Park Revegetation Project funded under the Swan Canning Riverpark Urban Forest (SCRUF) Program.

We currently have 40 community volunteers signed up to assist on the day.

Important event information:

- All Community Planting Day participants will need to complete the Volunteer Registration Questionnaire included in their Eventbrite ticket registration;
- Parking will be made available off Fauntleroy Avenue, and in the Hilton Grove car park. Follow signage to the planting location within the Garvey Park Bush Land; and
- Children under the age of 16 years need to be supervised by a parent/guardian.
