## Revised Local Planning Policy No. 11 – Public Art Contribution

### Public Advertising

*Pursuant to Schedule 2, Part 2, Clause 4 (Deemed Provisions) of the Planning and Development (Local Planning Schemes) Regulations 2015*

The City of Belmont is seeking comment on the revised Local Planning Policy 11 – Public Art Contribution. The Policy has been revised to provide a contemporary framework for the provision of public art within the City, and to guide developers seeking to fulfill their public art obligations.

The objectives of this Policy are to:

- To enhance a sense of place by encouraging public art forms which provide an interpretation and expression of the local area's culture, environment and built heritage.
- To encourage innovation and creativity, and the community to interact with their environment and local cultural identity.
- To improve legibility by introducing public art which assists in making streets, open spaces and buildings more identifiable.
- To improve visual amenity through the use of public art to screen unattractive views and improve the appearance of the public realm.
- To create local landmarks acting as focal points for the City, enhancing public enjoyment, and understanding of places through the public's exposure to and understanding of public art.
- To ensure that there is equitable access to public art by placing it in locations that are accessible to all members of the community.
- To enhance the functionality and utility of public spaces by incorporating public art into the urban landscape.
- To require or impose a levy for contributions for the placement of public artwork in accordance with the Public Art Management Plan.
