

During my time on council, I have worked as part of a **team** to achieve results. We have focused on the growth and well-being of the Belmont Community.

**Some key highlights:**

- The creation of the Volcano Park & Belmont Skate Park
- The construction of the Wilson Park Netball Courts & Sports Lighting Upgrade, with a youth-oriented section with basketball courts
- Implementing the Your Neighbour Grant, (the idea came from a Rivervale resident)
- By working with the Mayor on the Perth Airports Municipalities Group (PAMG) we strongly advocated for Perth's parallel runway (to begin construction next year)
- Building the Harman Park Centre for my seniors to enjoy
- The creation of Jack Ring Park in Rivervale
- The building of the Belmont Hub; its library, Senior's Centre & museum
- October 2019 new exercise equipment at Harman Park for Seniors
- November 2019 Moved the motion to construct the City's first Pump Track and Play Space Facility at Forster Park (the idea came from a Rivervale resident)
- March 2020 Moved a motion proposing that the City requests the State Government to restore the Ascot kilns and stacks, and review the land use with a view to make the historic structures the centrepiece of a park and tourist hub
- 2020 moved the Financial Hardship Policy
- Supported the Positive Engagement Program (PEP) Flexible Learning Centre for our youth
- Supported the upgrade to the Belmont Police Station so it can house more police officers
- Supported The Safeguarding Families Advocacy Service which is a vital service in the Belmont community, providing critical support to residents experiencing domestic & family violence
- Following requests from the City, the Minister approved the construction of noise walls across both sides of Redcliffe Bridge
- Supported Council's COVID-19 response to have dog and cat registration fees waived (for 3 years now)
- Supported live streaming of council meetings
- Supported the enhancement of the Ranger services
- Supported more tree planting across the city
