However there are times when the donations being offered are not appropriate for use in our Library and require staff to sort and store the unwanted items.

To ensure the best possible resources are available to the community the following guide will assist those community members looking to donate.

- The Library service will generally accept new or near-new items.
- The following items will not be accepted by the Library service:
 - Dirty or damaged items
 - DVDS without an Australian rating (E, G, PG, M, MA, R)
 - Pirated copies of DVDs or music CDs
 - Ex-rental DVDs
 - Jigsaw puzzles
 - Used textbooks
 - Paperback novels that have been exchanged at a book exchange
 - Magazines
 - Items with written personal notes or messages on or in the item

Please contact a local charity if you wish to donate your used books to a worthy cause. Magazines are often welcome at refuges, hospitals or medical surgeries. Please contact these organisations directly.
