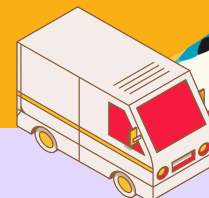

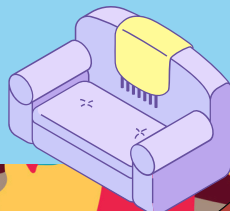


## Drop In @ The Base

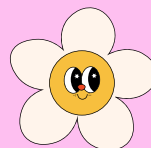
## Theatre & Film Project
